## **General Requirements** (determined by County of San Mateo and Puente):

- Live in Pescadero, La Honda, Loma Mar or San Gregorio
- Between 14 and 21 years old (must turn 14 years old by June 9, 2014)
- If you are 18 and over, you will be required to be fingerprinted and register for Selective Service.
- Eligible to work in the U.S.
- Income verification and other requirements (Puente will assist you to determine your eligibility)
