


# PUENTE ANNUAL REPORT 2013-2014

# COMMUNITY HEALTH AND WELLNESS

2013 and 2014 were robust years for health care outreach and expansion. Puente advocated for a new county-funded health clinic for the South Coast, which started serving farms and neighborhoods in 2015. For the first time, Puente brought healthcare providers “into the field” to treat farm and nursery workers and their families. We conducted the first-ever South Coast health survey to better reach those without reliable access to health care. **Puente is the bridge to fitness, preventative health care, and medical insurance for hundreds of people.**



Puente's partnership with the San Mateo County Health System brought immunizations directly to agricultural workers.

## HIGHLIGHTS

Hired Puente's **first** Community Health Coordinator

Gave “in the field” dental screenings and cleanings to **25 farm workers**; and **immunized 229 others** against tetanus and diphtheria; flu shots, skin screenings

Knocked on **1,500 doors** for South Coast health care survey

Enrolled **309 people** in health coverage and helped **133 people** navigate their benefits

Helped **140 people** file medical claims and resolve insurance disputes

Provided free behavioral health counseling to **155 people** for a total of **1,644 hourly sessions**

## OUR VISION

Within five years, **South Coast residents will have local access to integrated health and wellness services** (medical, preventative, behavioral, spiritual). Puente is developing a plan for a South Coast community health and wellness center, a hub where people and health services meet.

# ADVOCACY

## HIGHLIGHTS

**142 low-income neighbors** redeemed Pescadero Grown farmers' market tokens that matched their purchases, dollar for dollar.

**23 young people** received assistance with filling out and filing immigration documents for **Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA)** and 12 were assisted with renewal.

Gave **103 youth** a chance to attend YMCA Camp Jones Gulch, regardless of income

Recruited Spanish-English interpreters from Stanford and San Francisco State Universities to translate parent teacher conferences at the school district, helping **50 families** talk directly with teachers

Led a bilingual, community-wide **child sexual abuse education and intervention workshop**

Translated academic progress reports into a user-friendly Spanish template to be used for middle and high school parents.

Raised **\$32,000** for youth programs at Puente's first-ever Fall Harvest Fundraiser

Advocacy is the core of Puente's work on the South Coast. **We offer solutions and create ways to unite our community in unexpected ways.** Our weekly Pescadero Grown! Farmers' Market puts fresh, nutritious produce onto dinner plates at reduced prices for low-

income families.

Our summer camp partnership with YMCA Camp Jones Gulch gives a camp experience to students regardless of income. **Puente is the voice of the community.** We partner with San Mateo County as well as other nonprofits to create a better life for everyone.

## OUR VISION

A community is sustainable if its members are engaged and informed. **Puente will bring locals into the decision-making process for the South Coast and help them steer future policy by teaching self-advocacy and growing their participation in the issues that affect them most.**

# EDUCATION

From birth to adulthood, Puente's education programs continue to expand and help students of all ages further their education. In the 2013-2014 school year, Puente helped students excel through partnerships with two of the region's finest universities, Stanford and UC Santa Cruz. Puente's brand-new Family Engagement Initiative, a robust partnership with the La Honda-Pescadero Unified School District, will strengthen the bonds between home and school, promote early literacy and numeracy in South Coast families, and **create results before children enter preschool**. And thanks to Stanford Professor Guadalupe Valdés, Puente's innovative comprehension-based ESL classes are paying major dividends for students.

## HIGHLIGHTS

Forged new Stanford University partnerships to give **16 Pescadero students** unprecedented access to Stanford's academic and college mentorship programs

Brought **11-14 bilingual student tutors** each quarter from the University of California, Santa Cruz, into classrooms in Pescadero Elementary, Middle and High Schools

Partnered with the La Honda-Pescadero Unified School District to obtain a 2-year grant from the Heising-Simons Foundation to strengthen childcare, literacy and parent engagement programs for **120 local children aged 0-5**

**Enrolled 134 adults** in Puente's adult education program, **123 of them** in **comprehension-based ESL classes**

**Enrolled 17 adult students** in Spanish-language classes in La Honda

## OUR VISION

To give parents the knowledge and self-advocacy skills to direct their children's education. To create a sustainable early childhood education program that will give children and families a boost to succeed in kindergarten. To one day provide licensed childcare. And to give adult students opportunities for continuing their education so they can get better jobs and help their children in school.

# ECONOMIC SECURITY

## HIGHLIGHTS

Helped **52 South Coast residents** sign up for and/or use their CalFresh (food stamp) benefits

Prepared taxes, *pro bono*, for **152 locals** and got them **\$220,866 in cumulative income tax refunds** – a new record

Enrolled **898 people** in **economic security programs** and gave welcome bags to **69 newly arriving farm and nursery workers**

Spent **\$36,097** on agency-funded emergency rental assistance for **45 families**

Distributed Christmas holiday gift cards to **258 children and 71 families totaling \$13,750**, to buy groceries, clothing and other necessities

Thanks to you, our donors, **Puente is often the first and only stop for nearly 1,500 people each year**. People know we are an emergency resource for rent, utilities, information, bedding, clothing and toiletries. We are here for hot meals for farm workers and our Farmers' Market tokens program. We offer bicycles and bike repair. **Your extraordinary generosity makes this possible.** When Puente asked for emergency blanket donations to help residents weather below-freezing nights, **you donated 400 blankets and gave \$4,000 to buy more**.




